

Please read the following concerning the data contained in this spreadsheet:

This data is provided from the road traffic crash database - Crash Analysis System (CAS), and is limited to police reported injury crashes that occurred since 2014 to 2017 as recorded in CAS as at 14 March 2017.

Sheet 1 includes data on count of casualties resulted from intersection crashes in New Zealand where the most deaths and serious injuries occurred.

Sheet 2 includes data on count of casualties resulted from intersection crashes in the Greater Wellington region where the most deaths and serious injuries occurred.

Intersections are ranked by the largest number of deaths and serious injuries (DSIs), and then by the number of the highest level of injury severity sustained in a crash

There is a lag from the time of a crash to full and correct crash records within CAS, therefore 2016 and 2017 data is provisional.

In both lists, some intersections were ranked as "equal" in terms of number of injuries and deaths. As a result, Sheet 1 shows 22 intersections, and Sheet 2 shows 11 intersections.
