

We contacted the requester and refined the request to:

For the last 15 years to date (as of 20 Nov, 2017), what is the total cost of retrofitted median barriers around New Zealand? Please provide a breakdown of locations of roads where retrofitted median barriers have been installed.

What is the projected total cost (estimate) of construction of further median barriers along other stretches of roads in New Zealand, for the next five years?

However, I'd also like to know: When, where and (if possible) why were the first median barriers installed in New Zealand?

At the time of the refinement, the business believed information could be found and provided. As such, we extended the deadline by 20 working days in order to collate the information.

However, after further investigation, it appears that the costs of barriers alone cannot be extracted from the general contract costs without a significant amount of collation. An engineer from each individual project would need to look through all archived information on the project and isolate the costs of the barriers. As it stands, we have some information (attached) on the total costs of projects – most of which are already publicly available. The rest is just general recall from engineers.

For the last 15 years to date (as of 20 Nov, 2017), what is the total cost of retrofitted median barriers around New Zealand? Please provide a breakdown of locations of roads where retrofitted median barriers have been installed.

What is the projected total cost (estimate) of construction of further median barriers along other stretches of roads in New Zealand, for the next five years?

However, I'd also like to know: When, where and (if possible) why were the first median barriers installed in New Zealand?

I will respond to your questions below in the order they have been asked.

Your request for the total cost of retrofitted median barriers for the last 15 years has been refused under section 18(f) of the Act, as the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research. While the total costs of projects where median barriers have been installed are available, the extraction of information on the specific costs of these median barriers would have an unreasonable impact on the Transport Agency's ability to carry out its other operations.

Your request for projected cost estimates of construction for median barriers has also been refused under section 18(f) of the Act, as the information requested cannot be made available without substantial collation or research. Again, while estimated total project costs are available, information on the specific construction costs of median barriers would require substantial collation and consultation that cannot be performed without interfering with the Transport Agency's other operations.

The Transport Agency is investigating safety improvements over a number of corridors, which may include the installation of median barriers. No further estimates can be provided on the cost of median barriers for these improvements until the Transport Agency has calculated the necessity and work required to install barriers.
