Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 20 April 2018 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

What is the total dollar amount spent so far on the proposed Warkworth to Wellsford section of the Road of National Significance project?

Please give me a breakdown of how has this money been spent? (For example public consultation, engineer reports, planning of indicative routes etc.)

The overall cost up to 8th of April 2018 is \$16,909,993.07. The breakdown of costs is as follows:

Cost breakdown	Total (2012/13 to 8 April 2018)
Communications	\$989,980.93
Indicative/Detailed Business Case/Pre-implementation	\$9,374,874.53
Programme Management	\$3,280,317.36
Specialist Consultants (including Legal)	\$3,264,820.25

As stated in the Transport Agency Investment Proposal 2018–27, the New Zealand Transport Agency is proposing to complete the work necessary for designations to be put in place for the new road alignment. This will protect the proposed route for when it is required.
