My view is that any issues regarding the legality of the road markings falls within the NZTA arena to take up with Council.

I agree there is a potential increased road safety outcome risk with this set-up, with some pedestrians perhaps treating this as a normal pedestrian crossing, stepping out and expecting vehicles to stop. From that perspective, the Council should ensure all pedestrians (24/7) are very clearly informed that the rainbow crossing does not give pedestrians right of way. We will discuss this further with the Council.
