Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 10 December 2018 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

The cost of vouchers given out for WoF checks as part of NZTA's compliance review. Please calculate the cost up to today (December 10).

As of 10 December 2018, the NZ Transport Agency had paid \$25,844.22 for Warrant of Fitness (WoF) inspection vouchers which had been redeemed by customers.

I should also note that the figure provided above is subject to change, as the voucher redemption process takes place in two stages. Once customers receive a voucher they can take it to any WoF provider, who will then invoice the Transport Agency directly. Some providers do this invoicing daily, while others may invoice weekly or monthly.
