Visited Quality MS4770 Mechanical Limited, 808 Princes Street, and spoke to IO/VI S9(2)(a) S9(2) provided the check sheets for the two trailers concerned. He said he inspected them in the normal way in June 2018. The WOF Online system automatically allocates the WOF period applicable based on the registration plate number vintage. This was a 3 year WOF as the plates were new. As far as maintenance of the trailers goes, he has no contract to maintain them, the owners just get him involved when they note repairs are needed.

Visited BP Dunedin, 808 Princes street, and spoke to S9(2)(a) S9(2)(a) Advised her that I wished to inspect the trailers. She said the whole episode had been very stressful and disturbing, especially the man demanding money for the return of the trailers. She had deregistered the trailers and they were chained up outside so they could not be used.

I gave the trailers a cursory inspection to ensure they were not unsafe. Due to the WOF inspection being over six months ago the lights were not checked as they could malfunction at any time since the inspection. All components were in serviceable condition, the registration plates were missing as was the offending sign from 9U587.

The following is a summary of the reported issues:

- Is the NZTA confident it is a 2018 new trailer as claimed - The NZTA does not have direct involvement in the registration of trailers. It is a paper transaction done at the counter of a KSDP. Nobody has claimed the trailers are new, however the MR2b used to register them indicates they are new. S9(2)(a) said the old number plates were damaged and useless so she sent an employee down to get new plates. She did not mean "new trailer" plates, just new plates for the old trailers. Due to language difficulties the employee came back with new plates and S9(2) was unaware she had registered the trailers as new trailers.
- Are you aware of issues with old homebuilt trailers being passed off as new - Trailers do not have unique identifiers or build standards therefore a trailer can be made by anyone to any standard and

used in fit for purpose activities. As with any vehicle if registration lapses it is issued with new plates to the latest configuration when it re-enters the fleet.

- Given the "issued by" fields are not being filled out on the WOFs, are they legal - It is general practice to fill in the WOF label with a ball point pen. With heavy exposure to the sun the ink fades and often the label is then practicably blank, especially after more than 6 months. The labels were legal and at the time of their issue, clearly filled out.
- Was the NZTA formerly aware of the concerns around warrants issued by the Princes St BP - BP Dunedin does not hold a WOF appointment. The Appointment is held by Quality Mechanical Limited, next door. They have a good compliance history with the NZTA with very little complaint history. To date there have been no concerns.
- The NZTA has no input or jurisdiction over hire centres or service stations unless they hold a WOF appointment. Under legislation a trailer hire service is not required to have a rental license thus now involvement with NZTA.

Also, is a trailer able to be issued with a three-yearly WoF?

A man working at a local green-waste facility, Bill Gillanders, says a woman arrived with one of the trailers yesterday. He says he was helping her open the tail gate of the trailer when a large piece of sheet metal BP signage came loose, swung down on his thumb from its one remaining rivet, and almost chopped off his thumb. He has seized the trailer at the greenwaste facility, citing concerns the warrant/registration is fraudulent and the trailer is unsafe.

The trailer is registered as 2018-new and has a three year warrant, but judging by the trailer's appearance and general state of disrepair (see attached photo wof issues1) it would seem unlikely this trailer is 2018-new. As a result, Mr Gillanders believes the three-year WOF is fraudulent.

Please also find attached photos of the warrants of fitness for both the seized trailer (woftrailer1) and another rental trailer at the BP today (wof issues2). Neither warrant has the "issued by" field filled out, while the second warrant is completely blank.

A few questions follow on this, deadline 4pm today please and let me know if you have any questions:

- Given the general state of disrepair of the trailer seized by Mr Gillanders, with extensive rust and peeling floorboards, is the NZTA confident it is a 2018-new trailer as claimed?
- Are you aware of issues with old homebuilt trailers being passed off as new?
- Given the "issued by" fields are not being filled out on the WOFs, are they legal?
- Was the NZTA formerly aware of concerns around the warrants issued by the Princes St BP?
- Do you have any further comment on the concerns raised by Mr Gillanders about the safety of these rental trailers, and their allegedly fraudulent registration dates and therefore warrants of fitness?

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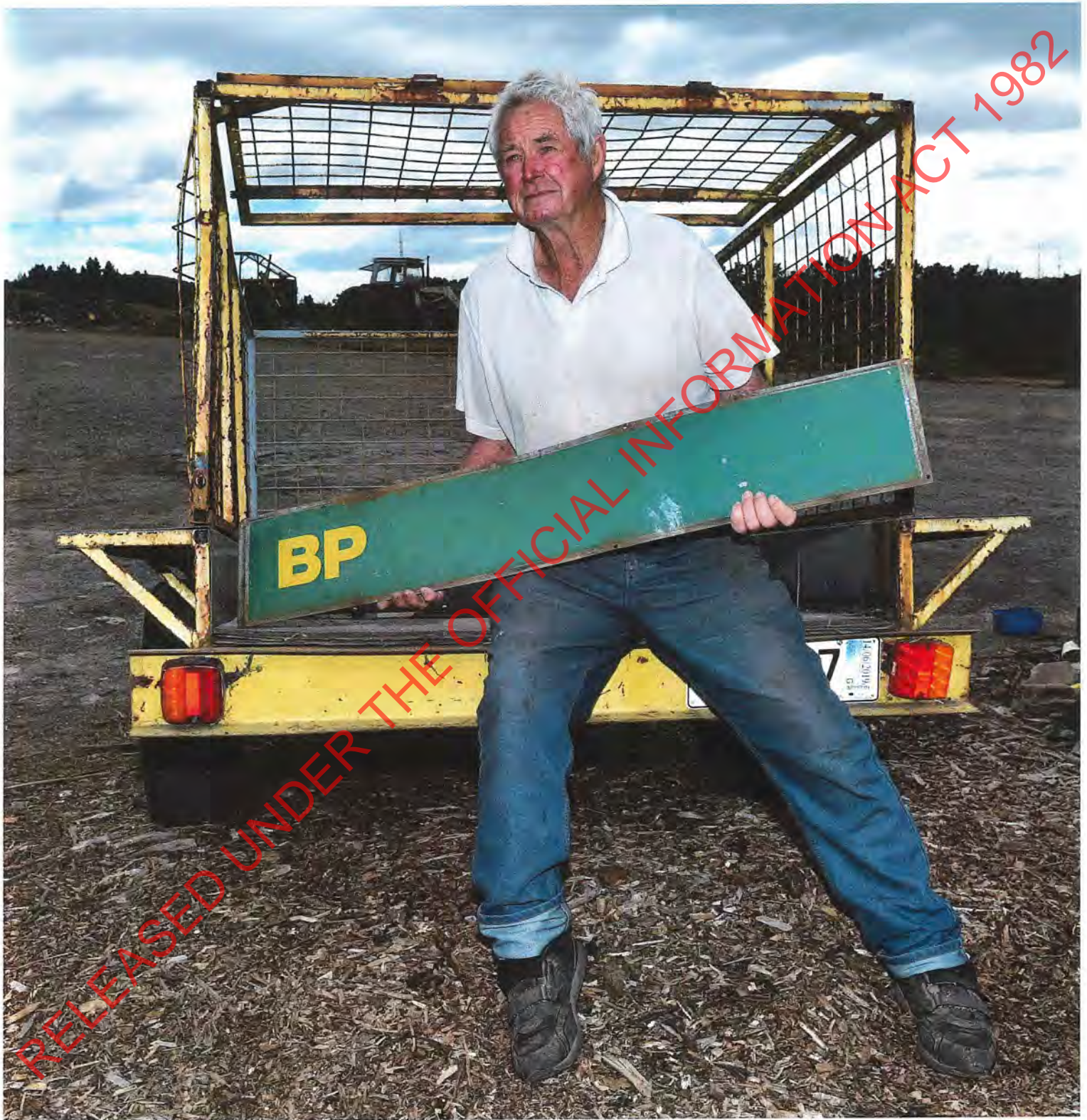

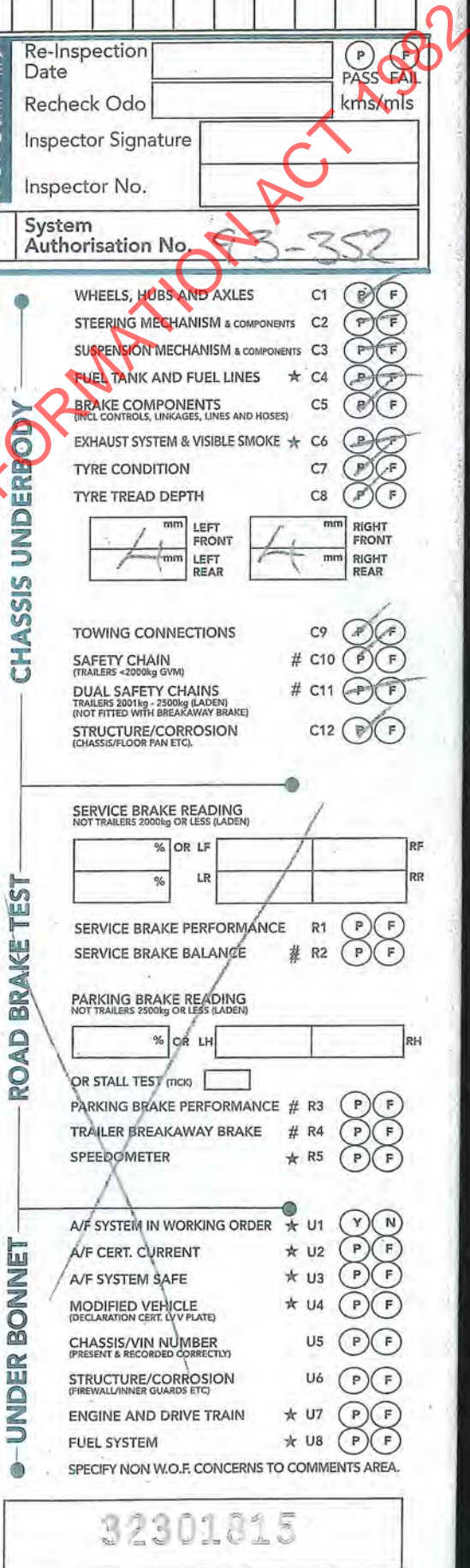
