On the go today:

1. **Petone to Grenada:** The statement below was provided to *RNZ* in response to questions about the re-evaluation of the Petone to Grenada highway project. The same response was provided to Stuff on Friday afternoon.

The Melling Interchange and Petone to Grenada are two of a number of projects currently being reviewed by the NZ Transport Agency, to evaluate whether they align with the new vision for our transport network. Once this work has been completed, work on these projects may proceed as currently planned, be staged differently or explore lower cost options. This could mean that previous shortlist options, or even the preferred option, may change. The NZTA Board met in December to consider next steps, however there is still more work to be done. We expect to be able to make announcements about decisions on these projects in the coming months.
