- **Note** the NZ Transport Agency has a review underway to ensure the tolling business is fit-for-purpose, and includes evaluating relevant legislative and policy frameworks, tolling systems and processes (including ensuring tolling assessments are in business cases for funding), and tolling application to ensure suitability for the current funding environment and practices.

- **Approve** the release of the decision to NZ Transport Agency staff and to the Minister of Transport (including the reasoning), allowing the Minister's Office opportunity to decide how further public messaging is managed, and by whom.

Strategic Relevance


Tolling of new roads is enabled under the *Land Transport Management Act 2003 (LTMA 2003)* to assist in funding the: 'planning, design, supervision, construction, maintenance, or operation' (section 46(1)(a) *LTMA, 2003*) of a road.

From 1 January 2013, it became Transport Agency policy to assess all new road links for tolling suitability, against a set of agreed criteria [refer to *Board papers 2013/03/0713* and *2013/10/0868*].

The decision whether to recommend tolling to the Minister sits with the Board; however, the final decision to progress a tolling recommendation into an Order in Council, including public consultation, sits with Cabinet.


