Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email to the NZ Transport Agency on 24 June 2019 requesting the following information under the Official Act 1982 (the Act):

*I would like to get an update on the registrations on Waiheke Island.
I would also like to see if I am able to get a bit information like each individual car that is registered including Year, Make, Model and registration plate.*

The data you requested has been provided to you in the attached spreadsheet (OIA – 5366 .xlsx: contains the data for vehicles registered to persons with a physical address identifiable as Waiheke Island).

It is important to note the following, also provided in the spreadsheet for your convenience.

- Data extracted from the Motor Vehicle Register (MVR) and is current as at 23 June 2019.
- Only vehicles with an active registration are included.
- Only vehicles where the sole motive power is recorded as ELECTRIC are counted as being full electric for the purposes of this report.
- Data is limited to vehicles registered under persons with a recorded physical address identifiable as Waiheke Island, or postcode is 1081.
- Address fields are free-text and self-declared, therefore subject to human error.
- A registered person's physical address does not denote the location where the vehicle is operated or located.
- Address information is only recorded against the person/entity in the MVR, not individually against each vehicle.

I am withholding the registration plate information under section 9(2)(a) of the Act to protect the privacy of natural persons, including that of deceased natural persons. This information combined with the information you have requested, and other publicly available information could enable the identification of individuals or personal details about them.

I do not consider that it is in the public interest to make this information available.

Under section 28 of the Act, you have the right to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision to withhold or refuse parts of your request. You can find the contact details for the Ombudsman at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.
