**Let's Get Wellington Moving**

We are writing to you following a meeting of the Wellington Region Mayoral Forum on Friday 22 June 2018. At the meeting we received a comprehensive briefing on the *Let's Get Wellington Moving* (LGWM) programme.

We are unanimous in supporting LGWM as the region's top priority. As you will appreciate, we consider LGWM to be a key aspect of how we will collectively work towards the development of Wellington, the region and ultimately New Zealand Inc.

We are working together on a broader regional investment programme which will include and extend beyond LGWM. The development of a Wellington Regional Investment Plan (WRIP) is focused on agreeing and prioritising a list of partnership opportunities for the region and the government. We will be seeking a meeting with you later this year to discuss the WRIP.

The New Zealand Transport Agency, Greater Wellington Regional Council and Wellington City Council will be considering LGWM proposals in August 2018. Following these decisions, those three agencies will seek a meeting with you to outline the agreed proposals for your consideration.

This is an exciting opportunity for our region and to further enhance its contribution to New Zealand as a whole and we look forward to presenting you with our proposals soon.
