**Request made under the Official Information Act 1982**

Thank you for your email of 12 September 2019 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act):

*...Just wanting to pop in a quick OIA request for the number of people who have a zero alcohol licence, at a) 1 July 2018 and b) 1 July 2019.*

The Transport Agency can confirm that as of 1 July 2018, there were 6,294 drivers with a zero-alcohol condition associated with their licence. As of 1 July 2019, there were 6,016 drivers with a zero-alcohol condition associated with their licence.

It is important to note the following in relation to the information provided:

- Data is extracted from the Driver Licence Register (DLR) and is current at 18 September 2019.
- The data is limited to drivers who held a current licence (with a zero-alcohol condition) as at 1 July 2018 or 1 July 2019.
- Only where a zero-alcohol condition has been applied to a licence above the standard conditions for the licence are included (i.e. the standard condition of drivers under 20 subject to zero alcohol level are not included).
