Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 19 September 2020 requesting information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) which on 2 October 2020 you refined to the following:

- Any reports and documents provided to the Programme Steering Group or Board which:
 - shows the *current* progress of all of LGWM's projects
 - details any unforeseen, or foreseen challenges which LGWM is currently having to overcome
 - examines the impact of these challenges, and any potential delays they might cause

Please note, this response is related only to your requests about the current progress of the Let's Get Wellington Moving programme and any challenges or delays. We provided you a response to your requests regarding the internal review on 5 November 2020.

Please find attached a copy of the following two documents that are in scope of your request:

- Document 1: 2020 August PSG Programme
- Document 2: Agenda items 3,4 and 5 from 2020 09 11 LGWM Partnership Board Agenda

These two documents provide general updates of progress in delivering the LGWM Programme and highlight items of interest or concern to the Programme Steering Group and the Partnership Board respectively.

Please note that the launch of the public education/awareness campaign that was scheduled for November 2020 was delayed to January 2021. Additionally, as part of developing the overall co-ordinated engagement programme the delivery of the Golden Mile Single Stage Business Case was pushed out to November 2020 for the draft and December 2020 for the final.

Some information is withheld from both documents under section 9(2)(g)(i) of the Act, to maintain the effective conduct of public affairs through the free and frank expression of opinions by or between or to Ministers of the Crown or members of an organisation or officers and employees of any public service agency or organisation in the course of their duty.

Some information is withheld from document two under sections 9(2)(b)(ii), to protect information where the making available of the information would be likely unreasonably to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied or who is the subject of the information; 9(2)(j), to enable a Minister of the Crown or any public service agency or organisation holding the information to carry on, without prejudice or disadvantage, negotiations (including commercial and industrial negotiations) and 9(2)(a), to protect the privacy of individuals.

You will note that I have removed some information from document two as out of scope.

With respect to the information that has been withheld, I do not consider there are any other factors which would render it desirable, in the public interest, to make the information available.

Under section 28 of the Act, you have the right to ask the Ombudsman to review my decision to withhold this information. You can find the contact details for the Ombudsman at www.ombudsman.parliament.nz.
