Hi Chris Hope all is well at NZTA with all this snow.

I had a call from the other day after I saw u in relation to suggesting the removal of some of the trees at the entrance of Rapid 2749 ie all on NZTA land. Travel from their entrance out onto SH1esp heading south requires special attention as vehicle travel fast down off the hill going north.
