Question: 1. A breakdown of pass rates for learners, restricted and full licences for the past six years. This should include the total number of tests taken, the percentage which passed, the location, year, and licence type.

2. For each licence type (learners, restricted and full), can I please request a breakdown of what percentage of all the people who tried for their licence in 2022 passed on their first attempt, second attempt, third attempt, fourth attempt and so on. i.e - 50 percent of people trying for their restricted licence passed on their first attempt, 30 percent passed on their second.

3. What is the most attempts someone's made for their licence for each licence type (learners, restricted and full) both in 2022 and on Waka Kotahi's records.

In order for a restricted licence holder to have the 'I condition' removed from their licence, the licence holder is required to re-sit and pass the restricted licence practical test in a manual vehicle. The data includes applicants re-sitting their restricted licence test in a manual vehicle to have the automatic condition removed from their licence.
- Test volumes are determined by the number of tests sat, not the number of individuals who sat a test.
- Where a test site is not recorded against a sat test on DLR, the identification number of the outlet resulting the test is recorded instead. Therefore, the data provided for some test sites are based on the outlet resulting the test, and not where the test was sat.
- Test site names are as per DLR records which may be different to commonly used names for the testing site
- Testing officers can perform tests at more than one test site and more than one test type.
