Request made under the Official Information Act 1982

Thank you for your email of 6 April 2023 requesting the following information under the Official Information Act 1982 (the Act) relating to a clip-on bridge over the Auckland Harbour:

All information that related to this apparent dynamic movement issue, all statements, calculations (including magnitude, frequencies, causes), reports, and emails held by yourselves or your contractors/consultants etc that relate to the dynamic movement of the clip-on lanes both with a combined single traffic lane / active mode lane and a two lanes of active modes. Please also provide any information relating to how any issues could be addressed.
