Only one bridge change this month but work continues to increase 50MAX access

Waikato District Council has continued to make progress with their bridges and have cleared the **Makomako Rd Bridge** for 50MAX access this month.

Progress is still being made with those councils that have yet to join the network and further bridge screening work to check suitability for 50MAX is continuing. One further South Island council has signed up, and we are finalising the information for publishing in the December update. Watch this space...

We have also had some feedback that 50MAX applications are sometimes not reaching us.

Here is a tip – if you have successfully submitted your application, the screen will display the message below (fig1). If this message **does not** appear there is an issue with the application. Thank you for submitting your application for a SOMAX permit to the NZ Transport Agency.

We will endeavour to respond to your application within three working days.

As always there have been changes to the network over the last few months, so operators are reminded to keep up to date regarding restrictions on the 50MAX network using the <u>50MAX interactive map</u>. This map enables 50MAX permit holders to identify a safe route for their journey. The maps are fully zoomable – just like google maps.

Please ensure all drivers are aware of the special conditions that apply to any 50MAX permit. 50MAX permits include a list of restricted areas, and operators and their drivers will need to study the book of maps they receive with their permit. The book of maps shows where 50MAX trucks can travel, and points out any no-go areas, such as specific bridges that are not fit for 50MAX traffic.If you have any questions please contact us at info50MAX@nzta.govt.nz or call0800 699 000.
