

**EXPLICIT AUTHORITY FOR TRAVEL ON TOLL ROUTE – TAURANGA EASTERN LINK (TEL).
Issued under schedule 8 of the Vehicle Dimensions and Mass Rule 2016**

Waka Kotahi NZ Transport Agency (**Waka Kotahi**) provides explicit authority for an operator of an Overdimension vehicle/s outlined in Schedule 1 to travel on the Tauranga Eastern Link Toll Road (TEL) subject to the conditions outlined Schedule 2.

This authority remains in place until such time as it is replaced or revoked by Waka Kotahi.

Schedule 1:

This authority enables the movements of overdimensional loads and/or vehicles as described under Clause 6 of the Rule. These include:

- Category 1,
- Category 2,
- Category 3,
- Category 4 and 4b

Schedule 2:

Travel on the TEL is subject to:

1. The operating conditions shall be in accordance with the category outlined in Schedule 6 of the Rule; and
2. In addition to weekday travel time requirements outlined in Schedule 6 of the Rule, movement cannot be made between 0600hrs and 0930hrs as well as 1530hrs and 1830hours.
3. Vehicles must travel at a safe and appropriate speed for the environment, without unexpected delay to other roads users
4. This authority may be revoked at any time by Waka Kotahi by notice on the Waka Kotahi website.

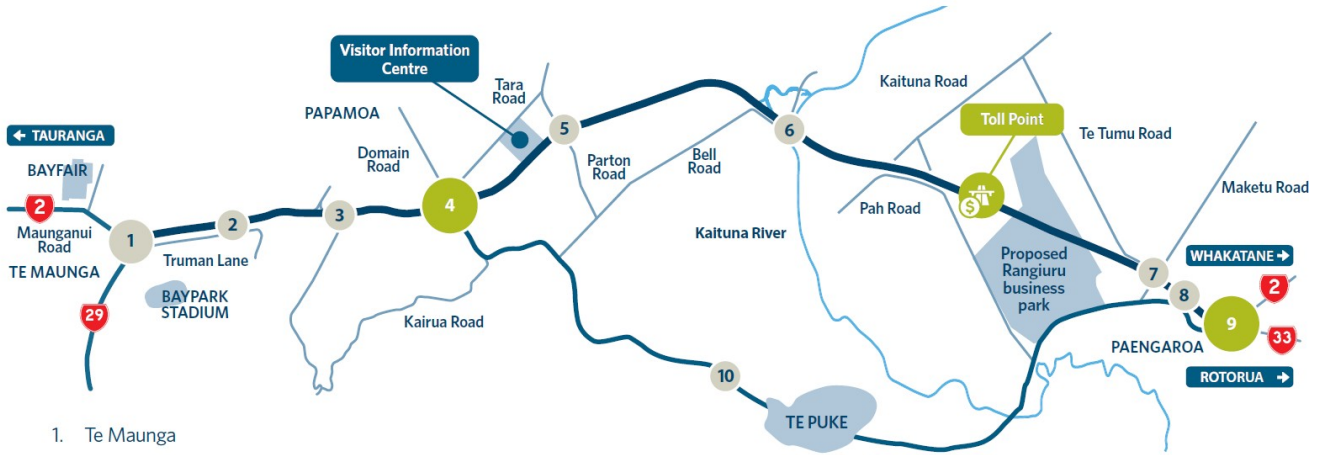
