REWM Roadtest involvement – BOP East NOC

- Resource Efficiency Guideline DRAFT Version 5 (Sep-21)
 - Provided some early feedback on the document
- Trial run of guidance (Section 3.1) to **identify** opportunities
 - Workshop held, electronically via MS Teams due to Covid (Oct-21)
- Review of REWM Reporting Form (Mar-22)
 - ‘Dummy’ review only; no practical use

Identifying opportunities (initial workshop)

- Get the right people in the room
 - Management perspective, field perspective.
 - Consider targeted/separate workshops for different types of activity – e.g. reseals vs routine maintenance.
- Take time to set the scene / context
 - It's likely this is a new area of focus for participants.
 - Provide background info to get them thinking along the 'right' lines.



REWM Reporting Form

- Just start with the easy stuff, the quick wins
 - What you're already recording & reporting.
 - Other info/records readily available.
 - Watch out for potential issues with aggregation of data, particularly if managed centrally (e.g. Higgins used to be a single line item in Fletcher Building's reporting system).
- Look next at what's easy enough with just a little effort
 - e.g. Info/records available but need a bit of time/effort to collate & report
- Decide & clearly define/document decisions made on how/when you're reporting
 - e.g. Reporting materials when ordered vs when used on the network
