

Making the road safer for agricultural vehicles

We leave regular gaps in barriers, and at intersections and entranceways, so wider agricultural vehicles can easily pull off the road. There will usually be space around driveways, too, so these large vehicles can pull over. When large rural vehicles need to make a right hand turn, they can still pull off to the left side of the road and turn right when it's safe.

Vehicles wanting to pass will need to wait for a gap or overtake by going across the centreline when it's safe. We know when road barriers are in place, drivers are less likely to attempt risky passing manoeuvres.
