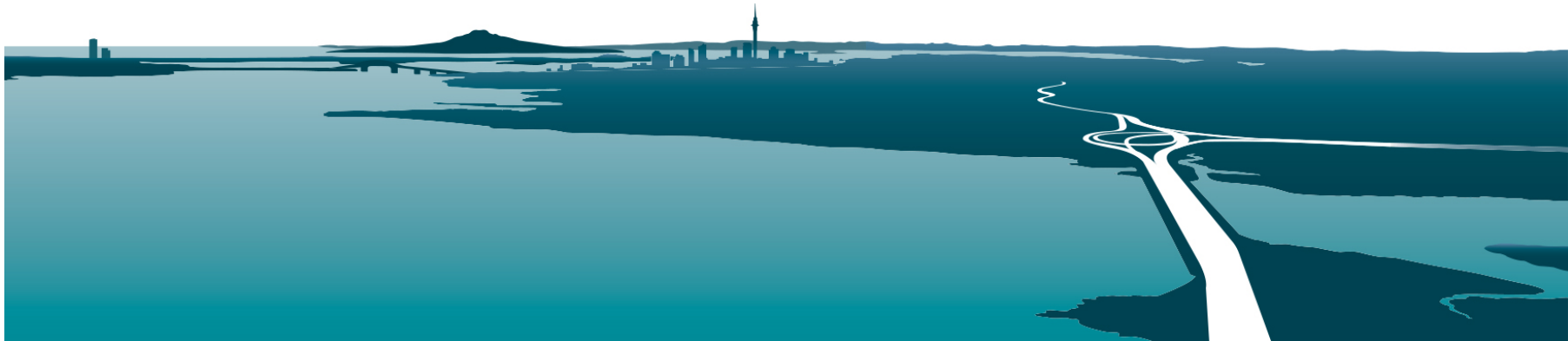

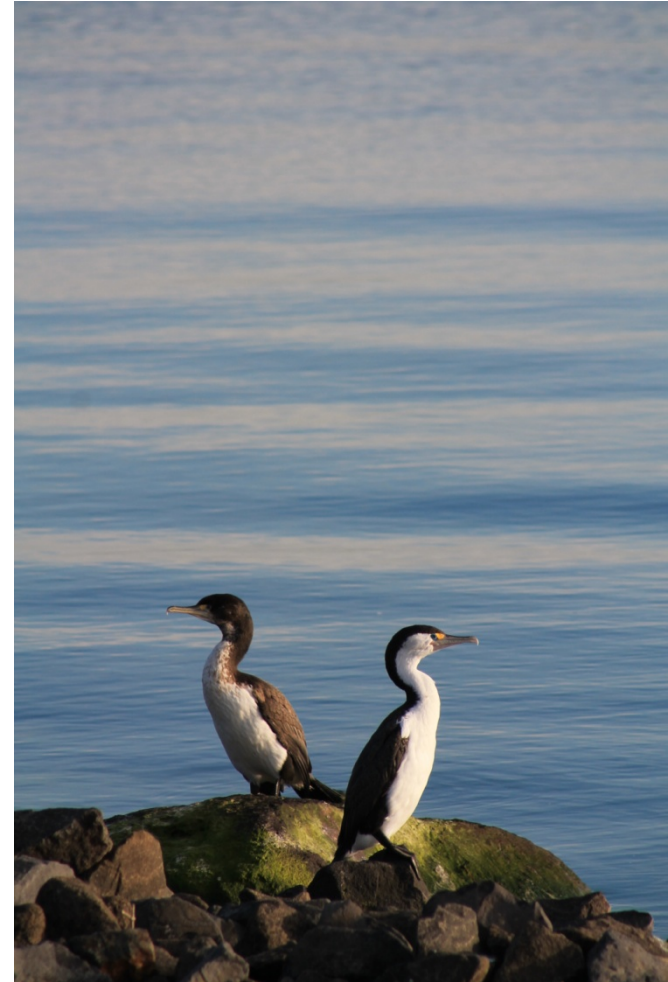


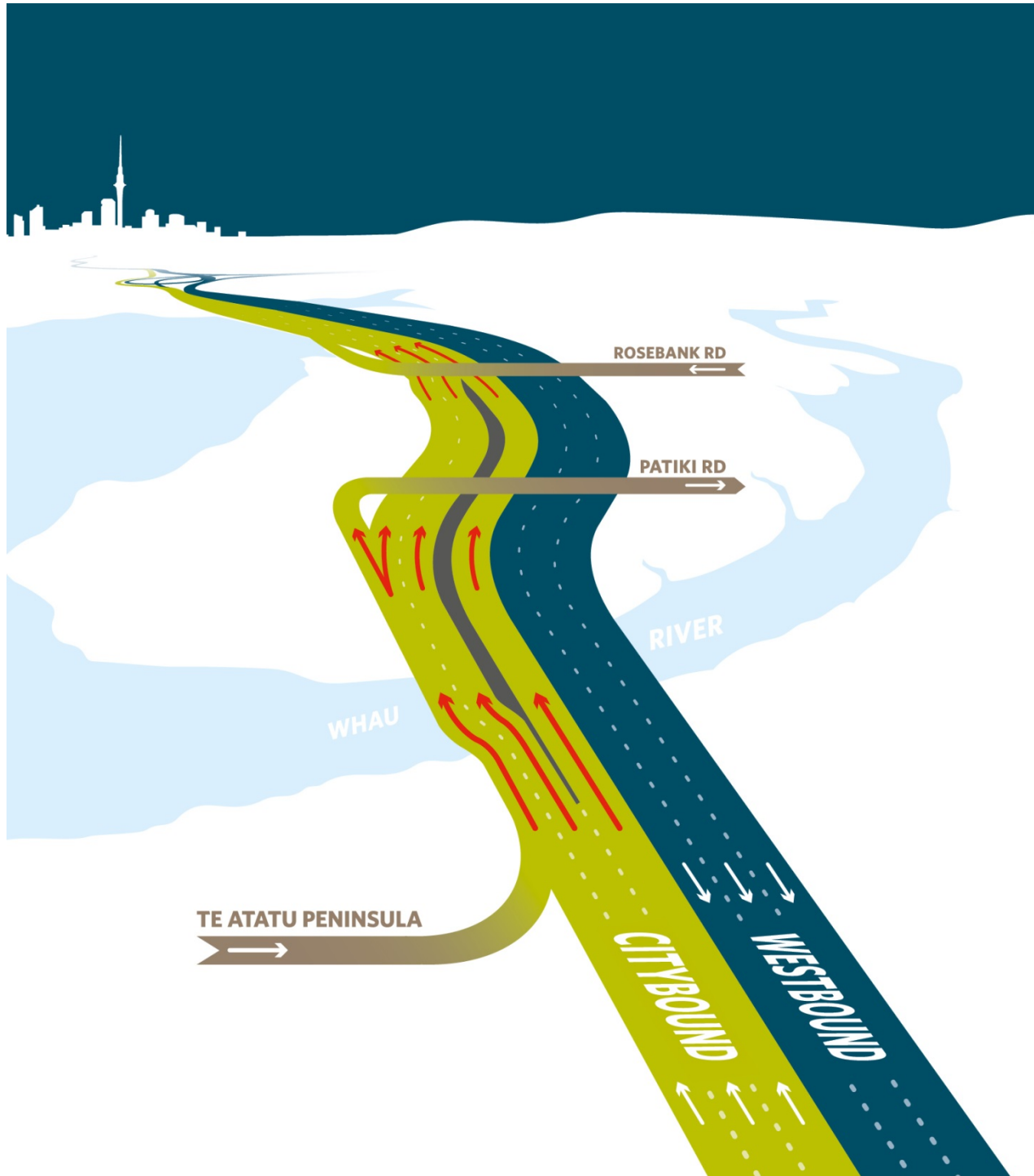

# Upcoming traffic management

- Intermittent night and weekend closures on Te Atatu Road (not affecting the motorway) – widening/strengthening work on Bridge 1
- Just before Easter citybound on-ramp changes from Peninsula
- Easter weekend Fri 3 Apr – Mon 6 Apr - lift southbound Bridge 2
- After Easter - part weekend closure for widening stitch work on Bridge 1
- Several Pedestrian route changes

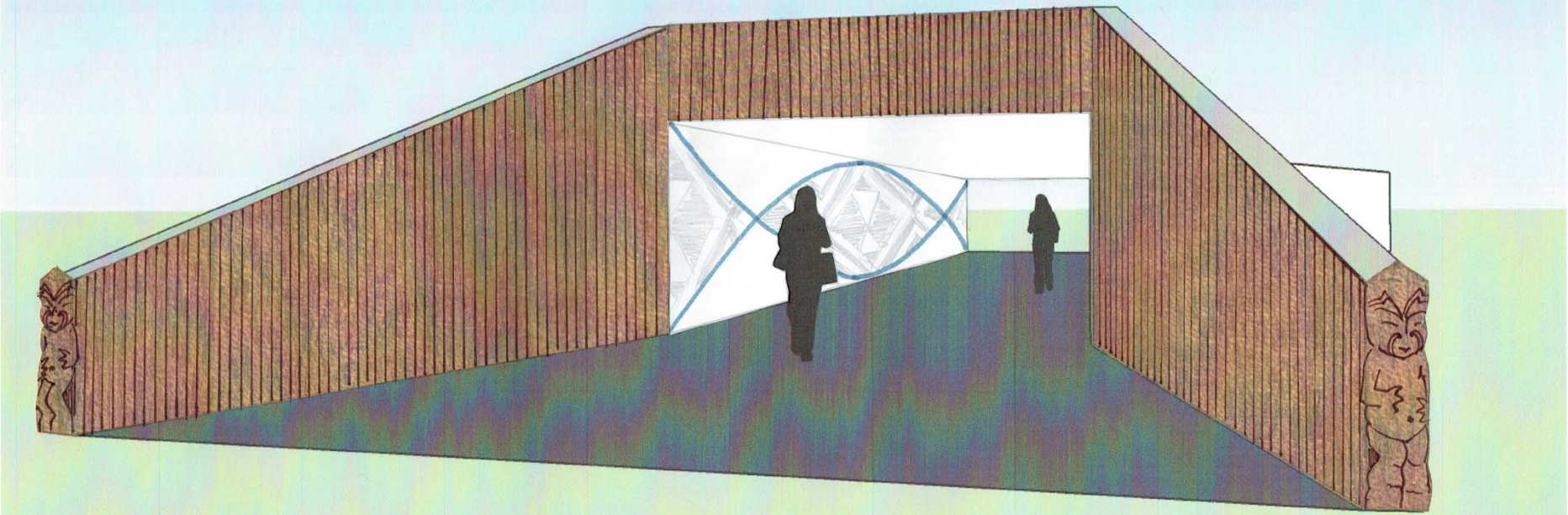




## Iwi art in design update

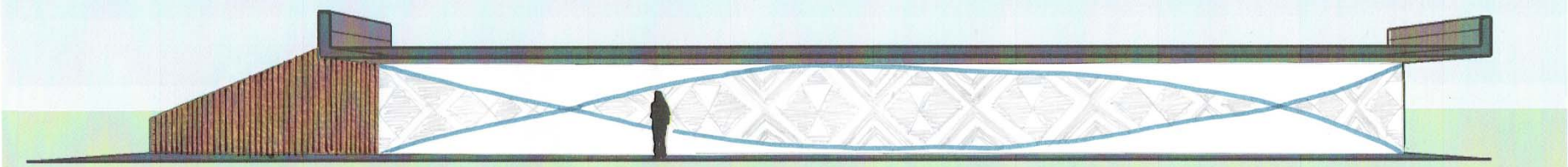
- Agreement reached with Auckland Council, NZ Transport Agency and Iwi on art in underpasses and on bridge balustrades

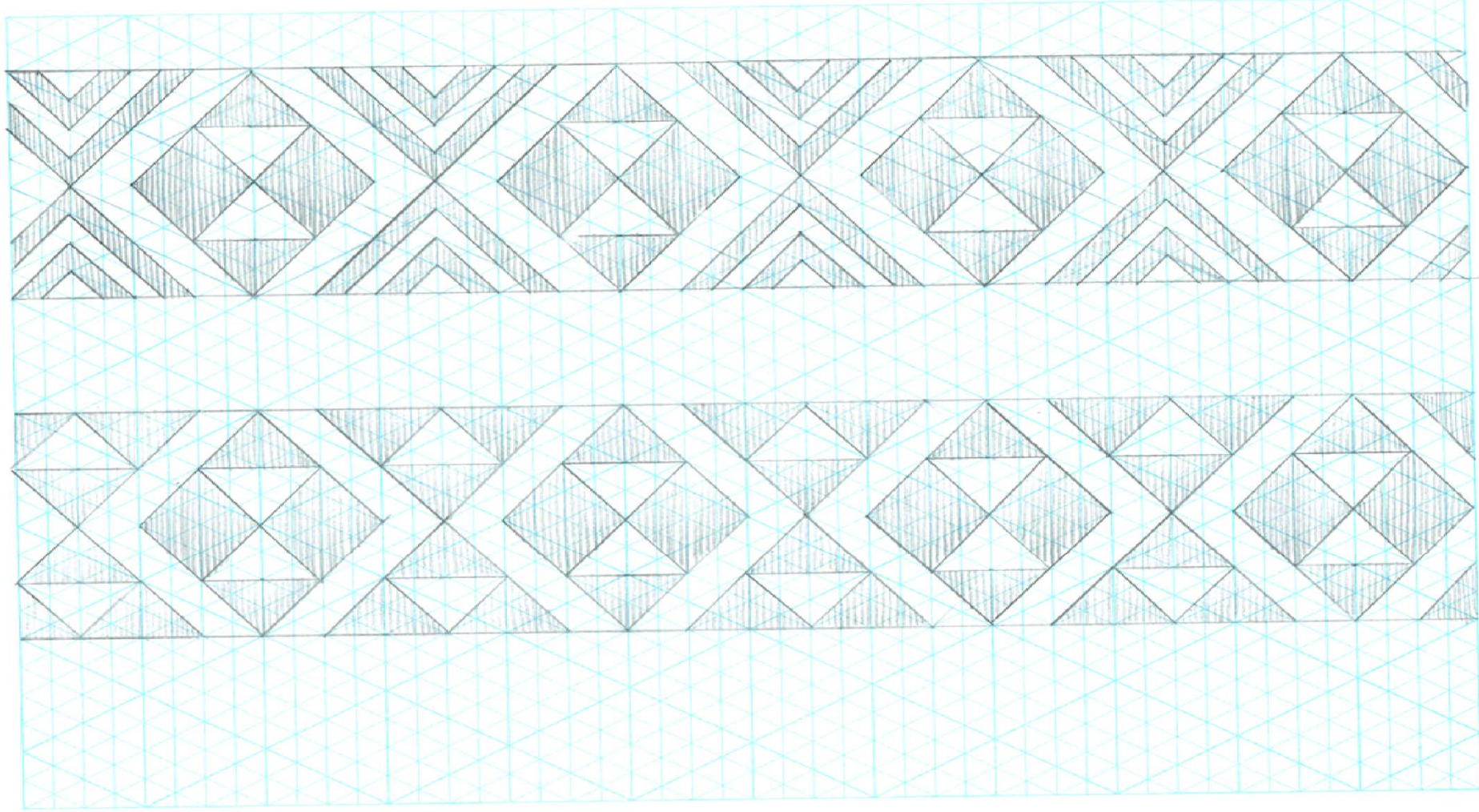
