## Progress Bulletin 14 – July 2014

**A quick bulletin to bring residents and businesses affected by the road works along this route up to date with what is happening and the immediate plan ahead.**

We are pleased to inform you that the 4-laning work along Carmen is almost finished.

### **Yaldhurst Rd to Buchanans Rd**

The new road construction is complete in this area and the road was opened to four lanes in late May.

The final asphalt at the intersections of Kintyre Drive and Steadman Rd has also been laid and road marking has been done through the entire area. The final asphalt for the remainder of this area will go down after winter; we expect this to be during October. The asphalt through this remaining area is a different grade and we require the road to be bedded in for an extended period to check for any settlement before we lay the final asphalt through this area.

### **Buchanans Rd to Waterloo Rd**

The new road construction and final asphalt surface are now complete through this area. Work has begun on the landscaping of the median island and the new road markings will be done soon.

We plan to have this area open to four lanes by late July.

### **Waterloo Rd to SIMT Railway**

All work is complete through this area and it was opened to four lanes in late June.

### **Waterloo Rd and Intersection Upgrade**

Work is largely complete through this area with the final tidy up well under way. We plan to be finished in the next few weeks and have this area fully opened by mid-July.

The traffic signals are all installed and the final commissioning is planned for mid-July, at this time the right-hand turning arrows on Carmen Rd will also become operational and the intersection upgrade will be complete.

**Finally, we would like to thank you all for your patients throughout this 4-laning project. We hope you will enjoy driving on this new, more efficient road – Drive Safe**
