

## Johns Road upgrade – Four laning Sawyers Arms Road to Harewood Road Stage One - Important Traffic Management Update

As part of NZTA's ongoing State Highway 1 improvements, City Care is upgrading Johns Road between the Sawyers Arms and Harewood Road roundabouts to four lanes. We are currently working on the northern side of Johns Road and in order to complete work, we will need to **close access to McLeans Island Road from Johns Road for approximately three months from Monday 25 February to Friday 31 May.**

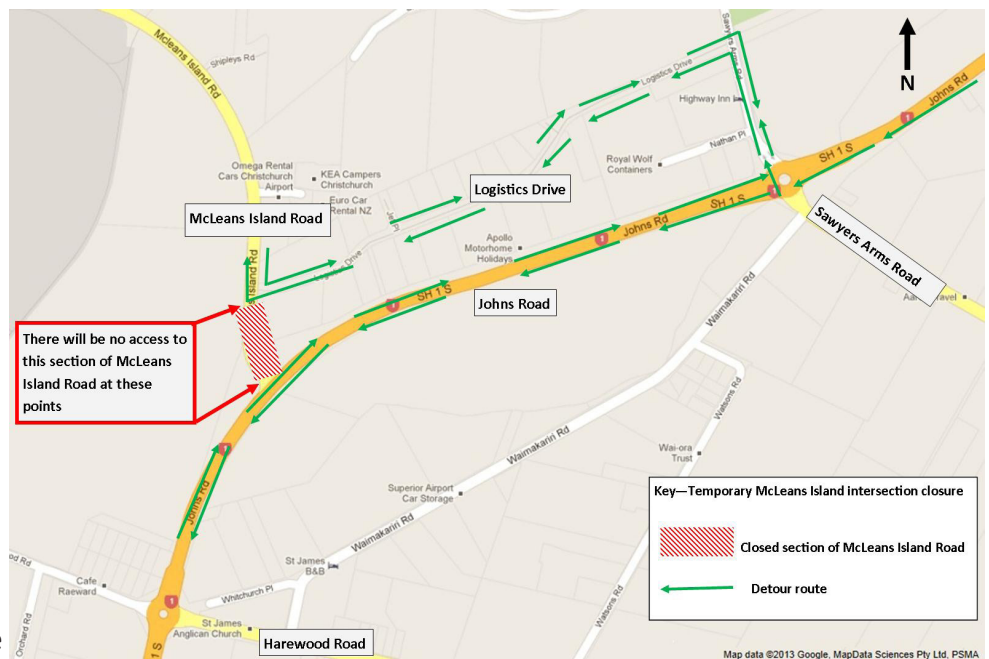
### WORK THAT WE WILL BE DOING

- We will be replacing the current McLeans Island Road intersection.
- The new intersection will have separate lanes for traffic turning left into McLeans Island Road and for traffic turning left out of McLeans Island Road.
- This work will happen alongside our work four laning Johns Road.
- When this work is completed, McLeans Island Road will be left in and left out only.

### TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

#### INFORMATION - refer to map

- Access to and from McLeans Island Road to Johns Road will only be available via Logistics Drive.
- Detour signs will be in place to let drivers know what to do.
- Motorists are asked to please follow all traffic signs.
- Pedestrians and cyclists will still be able to access McLeans Island Road from Johns Road, however we ask that extra care be taken when near the worksite.
- Please follow any additional traffic management signs that indicate the temporary speed limit.
- Please follow the instructions of all onsite traffic management staff.
- Traffic flow along Logistics Drive will increase, we ask all road users to take extra care especially when exiting properties.
- We will continue to maintain two-way traffic along Johns Road.



## GENERAL INFORMATION

- All work is subject to favourable weather and on-site construction conditions and therefore delays are possible.
- We do not expect any interruptions to your existing water, wastewater or telecommunication services while we do this work.
- Work will take place between 7.00am and 6.00pm from Monday to Friday and between 9.00am and 2.00pm on Saturday.
- Work may also be done at night or on Sundays if required to minimise traffic delays during busier times. We will let local residents know if night work is scheduled. Please continue to follow all traffic management signage and requests during these hours.

## WE CARE ABOUT YOUR SAFETY

- As part of this work, we will be using various pieces of equipment, including some very large machinery. Please remain aware of your surroundings at all times as visibility is not always easy from these machines.
- Please adhere to the cordons (fencing) around the worksite to ensure you remain safe.
- Should you need to speak to any of our workers on-site, please approach the workers furthest away from machinery while still remaining behind the cordon.
