Hi Glen,

Have just had a long discussion with **s9(2)(a)** re the Archaeological Discovery.

s9(2)(a) is working in conjunction with the Archaeological Authority and also a set of HPT guidelines in the event of Koiwi discovery. These are being followed.

s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)
s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii) the removal and storage of the human remains was being overseen by the Kaiharahi and the Kaitiaki.

In terms of Timelines:

- First remains discovered 4:00pm Wednesday 12th June 2019
- **s9(2)(a), s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)**

Remains have been placed in a secure area for the Archaeologist to carry out their works. **s9(2)(a)** also pointed out that this is a significant find with **s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)**, and has taken time to carefully remove the remains from where they lay.

There is two parts two the investigative works following a find.

- a. As part of the legal condition of the consent and in line with HPT Guidelines, **s9(2)(a)** needs to catalogue, **s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)** **s9(2)(ba)(i), s9(2)(j)** has indicated that this will take **s9(2)(a), s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)**
- b. The second step is a decision for Whanau to make. There can be an Osteologist examination done of the bones and materials **s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)** that have been uncovered. This will provide a lot more information **s9(2)(g)(i)**, but as stated earlier this is entirely up to Whanau to make. **s9(2)(a), s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)** **s9(2)(a), s9(2)(j), s9(2)(ba)(ii)**

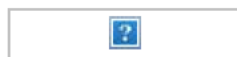
