

NEW WALKWAYS & CYCLEWAYS

To encourage more people to walk and cycle to key destinations such as bus stations, work, places of recreation and education, a network of over 30kms of walkways and cycleways is being proposed in the Albany area.

The Northern Corridor project is proposing a new shared path all the way along the new Busway extension, with a range of access points from the East Coast Bays. We are also proposing several new paths and highway crossings along the length of Upper Harbour Highway (SH18), linking into Albany Highway's new cycle paths. These would be built from 2018.

A wide range of connecting walkways and cycleways are also being investigated to link to the new Northern Corridor paths. When completed this network will provide people with more transport choice, encouraging safe and enjoyable trips by walking and cycling.

This network is being investigated by the NZ Transport Agency, Auckland Transport and Auckland Council.
