### Key topics

The main purpose of this month's event was to update project neighbours and the public at the Visitor Information Centre. This was the first open day to take place after the Alert Level 4 lockdown and members of the public could attend throughout the day to receive the latest updates including new aerial photos and video.

The local community were notified via a flyer delivered to their letterbox, and an email was sent to the e-news database ahead of the event.

As well as general queries about the project as a whole, other key feedback and queries received included:

A former career engineer inquired about the SH1-18 underpass and our piling construction method. Jonathan handled the technical questions and ran him through the pile type and overall construction sequence. He stated he worked for Beca for a long period during his career. Jonathan informed him we were currently widening the existing Constellation Drive Bridge that was originally designed by Beca in the early 90s and asked if he would like to see the original drawings. He reviewed the drawings and recognised the names and signatures of his former colleagues who he was working with at the time.

### Key social impacts and future project mitigation recommendations for project team

Questions were raised and responded to about motorway signage, noise walls and if bollards will be put in place to stop cars from driving through the Alexandra Stream Underpass when it is completed.
