**Key topics**

Information session held for residents to drop in and get an update on the project’s current and future works. The latest aerial flyover video of the project taken in February 2022 was shown and paused at intervals so Trish could talk in depth about the work taking place and future works happening this year. A number of project boards and photos were displayed.

**Notification of the event**

The Drop-In Information Session flyer was emailed to the Retirement Village Manager, Grant Klenner, who emailed it to the residents and hard copies made available for delivery. The flyer also sent to NCI’s Greenwich Gardens database. A copy of the flyer was displayed on the Village Events Notice Board.

**Feedback**

Overall there were positive comments about the project. Questions raised and comments made during the session included:

- When is the project going to finish?
- How do I get from SH1 to SH18 and SH18 to SH1?
- When will the SH1 to SH18 underpass open?
- When will the shared paths be finished?
- Why is the entire Paul Matthews Road shared path closed when we are only working down one end?
- Why is it taking us so long to construct, we should be finished by now?
- Why aren't we getting more staff to finish the work faster?
- Why are we not building a connection from the west to south to directly access the city?
- Has the busway made any difference since we opened?
- Can we plant a tree/s on our side of the fence to block the resident’s view of the new gantry lighted sign and to help with reducing pollution?
- Why is the second left turn at the Constellation Drive off-ramp not operational, when will it open?
- Why is the shared path not finished between Caribbean and Rook Reserve?
- When will the Rook Reserve planting be completed?
- The Caribbean Drive intersection lights only let three cars through at off-peak times. Cars are running red lights.
- The traffic congestion on SH1 at Greville Road has got worse.
