Key topics

The project team hosted a site visit with members of the WSP Young Professional Pathways Group. An update of the project was given by Engineering Manager Shaugn Jansen in the project office's visitor hub, prior to going out on to site to visit a number of key areas.

Staff conducted a tour of the project with stops including the Albany Busway Bridge, McClymonts Road Bridge to look at the pou whenua and the SH1/SH18 Underpass. A detailed overview was given by NCI staff at each stop.

- How do you balance productivity versus safety in a dangerous environment such as the excavation?

- Were there any flooding issues in the underpass during construction?
- Is there a specific rain event that OGPA is designed for?
- Why are the slipform barriers not cast hard up against the precast panels?
- Where in New Zealand are the precast concrete suppliers based?
- Do plant/ materials get stolen from site?
- Did we have any carbon emission KPIs on this contract?
- What is our proudest part of the project?
- Have you had any members of the public using the SUP although it is not open?
- Why is it good for designers to work in an alliance or get on site experience?
- What are the Alliance partners responsible for during the Defects Liability Period?
