Key topics

The project team hosted a site visit with teams from three local Fire Stations: Albany, East Coast Bays and Takapuna. Three fire trucks attended on the first visit and two fire trucks on the second visit. The fire trucks were escorted into site by the NCI traffic management team. The firefighters were then led through the underpass by NCI staff, where they were given an explanation about the fire protection, the number of fire hydrants and traffic lanes.

Notification of the event

Invitation to visit the site sent the three local fire stations.

Feedback

Key questions raised during the visit included:

- Operational questions relating to the location, number, how the crew would gain access to the hydrants?
- Clarification on the technical specifications of the fire hydrants including if the fire brigade normal manhole key opens the new fire hydrant lid?
- Will there be a fire hydrant sign painted on the wall at a later date?
- General questions about the underpass:
 - Will there be lights?
 - How many lanes will the underpass have?
 - Is this the final surfacing on site?
 - When will it open?
- Questions about fire proofing measures in the underpass:
 - What fire protection will be in place?
 - Will the concrete panels be fireproofed/painted?
