Key topics

The project team hosted a site visit with a team from Roads Australia. An overview of the project was given by Alliance Project Manager Hamish Matthews in the project office’s visitor hub, prior to going out on to site to visit a number of key areas.

Staff conducted a tour the length of the project from SH18 to SH1, starting at the Albany Highway connection to SH18. Stops included a vantage point to look over SH1 and the SH1-SH18 connections, Tirohanga Whānui bridge and the SH1/SH18 Underpass and the SH18 viaducts. An overview was given at each stop.

- Are you proceeding with Rosedale Station?
