**Key topics**

The main purpose for this month’s info day was to host a drop in session for a selected group of interested parties to find out more information about the Car Parking Management Plan. This was required as part of the consent conditions to produce operational management plans for the new Hockey facility currently under construction as part of the Northern Corridor Improvements project. Collateral for the drop in session included:

- Poster of new Harbour Hockey facility
- Poster of new Harbour Hockey facility and Bush Road footpath and pedestrian crossing
- Feedback forms.

Staff gave an overview of the new carpark and facility and responded to questions from business owners.

**Notification of the event**

A letter invite was emailed and posted to all interested parties outlined in the resource consent conditions, including some owners of businesses on Bush Road not included in the consent conditions.

**Feedback**

General feedback was positive about the new facility and the car parking management plans. Key feedback themes included:

- General support for construction of the new facility including maintaining access in and out of Bush Road (for neighbouring businesses)
- Car parking at existing hockey centre and could this still be utilised by commuters
- When is construction starting of the new SH18 motorway lanes going over the nearby hockey land
