



# How we evaluate the options

A three-stage Multi-Criteria Analysis (MCA) process was used to trim the long list to a short list. At each stage, options with poor ratings were discarded, with remaining options proceeding to the next stage.

The highest rated options were selected as a short list for further evaluation and discussion.

## STAGE 1

### Set project objectives

Central Corridor: inner city safety, travel choices, accessibility, and vitality and amenity

Eastern Corridor: capacity, safety, travel time and reliability

## STAGE 2

### Identify risks and opportunities

Includes technical, consents, operations and maintenance, safety, funding, and public and stakeholders

## STAGE 3

### Assess environmental and social impacts

Includes transport and land use integration, social, environmental, heritage and property
