CONNECTING PEKA PEKA

CONNECTIVITY CONTEXT

The Kāpiti Expressway has recently opened and as part of the operational review the Transport Agency is investigating connectivity to and from the Expressway for the Peka Peka and Te Horo communities. This includes looking at the issues and opportunities from the Peka Peka interchange to the Ōtaki river.

The current issues identified for these communities include:

- Good access to the Expressway if coming from, or heading north
- Longer travel time to the Expressway if coming from, or heading to the south
- The confusing and complicated nature of access.



OPTION SELECTION PROCESS

LONG LIST STAGE

Long list options considered and assessed. This included the consideration of 18 different connectivity options. Options at Peka Peka, Te Horo and local road enhancements were considered at this stage.

SHORT LIST STAGE

Short listed options are then developed in more detail and assessed again in more detail against project objectives, feasibility, impacts of implementation and the costs. This assessment identifies a recommended option.
