

From **early 2017** the following information will be available on our website:

- 1. A non-technical summary that summarises all of the key pieces of information in the documentation including the Project description and Assessment of Effects on the Environment (AEE).

- 4. Drawing Set

2. The full AEE. The AEE provides a full description of the project, the alternatives considered, an analysis of the project's actual and potential environmental effects, recommended mitigation measures, and an analysis against the relevant policy documents

3. Technical Reports and supporting information

Once the application has been formally notified by the EPA, this information will be available to download from the EPA website and in hard copy at a number of locations (likely Auckland Council service centres, however this will be confirmed closer to the time).
