SUBMISSIONS TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AUTHORITY (EPA)

The period for public submissions on the East West Link closed on 22 March, and approximately 700 submissions were received. The EPA is processing these and says a list of all submitters and a summary of submissions report is scheduled to be released on 5 April on its website. Full publication of all submissions will also be available.



INFORMATION ON THE COMMUNITY PLAN

The Onehunga Business Association (OBA) presented an alternative plan for the East West Link to the Transport Agency last year, focusing on an alternative option for the SH20 interchange with the East West Link.

The Transport Agency further developed and assessed that design, in consultation with the OBA and the Onehunga Enhancement Society. To find out how this process was undertaken and the outcomes reached, have a read of this newsletter.
