The East West Link is a priority project for the long term growth of Auckland and the economic development of New Zealand. It will provide a new link on the northern side of the Māngere Inlet between State Highway 20 at Onehunga connecting to State Highway 1 at the Mt Wellington Interchange.

## AUGMENTED REALITY APP

- 2) Onehunga Harbour Road grass verge in front of the Landing restaurant and bar
