



SH30 EASTERN CORRIDOR STAGE ONE



The Eastern Corridor Stage One project is a \$17 million investment to improve the stretch of SH30/Te Ngae Road from Sala Street to Iles Road.

This project is part of the Connect Rotorua programme of work, in partnership with Rotorua Lakes Council, to futureproof two of the city's key transport networks: SH30/Te Ngae Road and SH30A/Amohau Street.

OBJECTIVES

- Improved efficiency at key intersections
- Better opportunities for walking and cycling
- Safety improvements
- More predictable journey times

THE IMPROVEMENTS

- Upgrading the Tarawera Road and Sala Street intersections
- Improving the Puarenga Bridge Underpass
- 3.5km of new shared path and on-road cycle lanes
- Additional eastbound lane between Allen Mills and Iles roads
- New watermains installed along both sides of road

Construction started in February 2020 and is on track for completion in late 2021. We have completed most of the work at the Sala Street intersection. Work at the Tarawera Road intersection is expected to be complete by mid-year. The remaining work should have minimal impact on the community.
