
A new way into Tamahere is coming soon

Another important milestone for the Hamilton Section of the Waikato Expressway will be reached next week.

All SH1 traffic (north and south) will be shifted on to the Cambridge Road Bridge and northbound lanes of the expressway to make room for further construction works.

This change is significant as it means you'll be able to follow the route shown in blue to travel to your home from Hamilton, using the slip-lane from the expressway on to Bollard Road.

There will be no change to the way you travel to Hamilton – please continue using Alfred Main Drive and Birchwood Lane until later this year when the Alfred Main Drive on-ramp opens.



Temporary closure of SH1 on Friday 11 February from 6pm

To complete the traffic switch, CityEdge Alliance will close SH1 between the SH1-SH26 roundabout in Hillcrest and the SH1-SH21 Tamahere Interchange from 6pm on Friday, 11 February, until 6am the following morning. Access to and from Tamahere will be maintained via Newell Road and SH21-Airport Road.

The new route to Bollard Road will open to traffic from 6am Saturday 12 February

Traffic, north and south, will be using the new route so please keep to the left when travelling to Bollard Road from Hamilton.
