Mount Iron Roundabout - Traffic Update (November 2023)

Good progress continues on building a new roundabout to keep everyone safe and improve access for cyclists and pedestrians at the busy Mt Iron SH6/SH84 intersection in Wānaka. While not fully completed, the roundabout should be ready to use over the busy Christmas-New Year holidays. The expected full project completion date is April 2024.

What is different?

The traffic layout and management on or near the roundabout construction site. More details about this below. A lower 30 km/h speed limit that will stay until the project's completion.

Remember when travelling from:

- Albert Town give way to all traffic at the SH6/SH84 intersection.
- Wānaka take the left lane for Albert Town and right for Luggate.
- Luggate if turning right to Albert Town, give way to traffic from Wānaka, head straight ahead for Wānaka, turn left for Riverbank Rd.
- · Riverbank Road Give way to all traffic.



Make your trip less stressful by:

- Being prepared for delays.
- Allowing more time for your journey especially in peak morning and early evening traffic periods.
- Driving carefully.
- Observing on-site signs.
- · Following on-site signs and traffic management crew directions.

Thanks for your patience and following the directions of work site crews. This will go a long way to achieving what everyone wants, and that is getting this job completed quickly and efficiently, and keeping project crews, road users, and nearby residents safe.
