



Beaumont Bridge temporary traffic management changes

Dee Street traffic diversion

Work on the western approach to the new two-lane Beaumont Bridge on SH8 between Dunedin and Central Otago is ramping up as part of a push to get all the main road connections to the new bridge finished over the summer construction season.

On the western approach, there will be a full dig-out and rebuild of the existing highway past the Beaumont Hotel. While we do this work, traffic is being diverted from **Monday 14 November 2022** on to Dee and Westferry Streets to link with SH8 to Central Otago. (see map)

We expect a mid-December finish for the western road approach to the new bridge. If there's a risk of prolonged delays, only the eastbound section will be built pre-Christmas and we'll resume work on the western approach after Christmas.

The Dee Street diversion is approved for all vehicle types (including 50Max, HPMV, overweight and overdimension vehicles).

Measures will be in place to ensure the effective monitoring and management of any traffic congestion.

Meanwhile, traffic is expected to move on to the new eastern embankment from Friday 11 November to enable the placement of fill between the embankment and the new bridge's eastern abutment.
