

We're working through options for the Pepe Stream Bridge

We are working on a business case looking at replacement options for the Pepe Stream Bridge. This is expected to be complete by the end of 2021.

Here's where we are at with the process

After initial feedback from the community and key stakeholders on what is important in a new bridge design, we now have three proposed bridge options.

These options, as well as possible intersection treatments at Pepe Road and State Highway 25 are being presented at a public open day.

This is another chance for the community to be involved in the design of the new bridge. There will also be a chance for the community to have their say on options for possible intersection treatments at the Pepe Road and State Highway 25 intersection.

After this event, and once we have gathered all feedback, we will work through the final stages of the business case process.

When can we expect to see a new bridge?

Once the business case process is complete, we will be able to share the preferred option with the community. This is likely to be later this year.

Funding will then have to be approved before we can move into the design and then construction phases. We are committed to keeping the community well informed as we progress and encourage you to share this newsletter with anyone you think might be interested in signing up for our updates.
