



An update to the Petone to Grenada Link Road Project

Since our last update we've been continuing to refine our proposals for the new Petone to Grenada Link Road route and designs for the Petone and Tawa Interchanges.

Our investigations are progressing, but we still need to complete detailed investigation work before we can discuss our proposals with the community. We will be holding community workshops about the interchange designs, and closer to the time we'll let you know more about workshop dates, locations and how to get involved.

Our investigations involve us looking at the relationship of the Petone to Grenada Link Road proposal with other improvements along the highway and rail corridor, such as walking and cycling, how we improve safety, how we support more reliable journeys and more efficient movement of freight and public transport (both road

and rail). It's important we also consider the interchange options thoroughly. We need to consider multiple interchange options at both Petone and Tawa and get feedback from the specialist team and the councils involved.

Once we've done that we will be ready to start our discussions with local communities and the wider public. This process will provide the community, local iwi, landowners and other key stakeholders with the opportunity to ask questions and give their feedback before final design decisions are made.
