

Rangiriri project update

November 2017

Lane and ramp closures coming up

The project team would like to update you on upcoming works to apply the second coat of chipseal on the 4.8km Rangiriri section of the Waikato Expressway.

The works will start on Monday 20 November and finish by Thursday 30 November. We need fine weather to do the work so the finish date may be extended.

Sealing will take place day and night during this time to ensure it is done as soon as possible to reduce disruption.

For road users travelling on this section of SH1, a single lane north and south will be available at all times. However at some stages ramps will need to be closed to traffic. Detour routes will be in place through the interchanges nearby, at

Rangiriri and Te Kauwhata, and also at Wayside Road. The detour routes will be clearly signposted.

The reconstruction of Te Wharepu Road will continue during the diversions but will be open to two lanes.

Please take care when driving through the work zone. The signs and speed limits in the area have been put in place to ensure the safety of road users and work crews. Thank you for your patience while we get this important work done.

Planned closures

- 1 20 and 22 November: Rangiriri north-bound off-ramp will be closed with detours via Te Kauwhata off-ramp
- 2 21 and 23 November: Te Kauwhata north-bound off-ramp will be closed with detours via Rangiriri off-ramp
- 3 27 and 29 November: Te Kauwhata and Rangiriri south-bound off-ramps will be closed with detours via Wayside Road. All local traffic will need to leave the highway at Wayside Road
- 4 28 and 30 November: Rangiriri south-bound on-ramp will be closed with detours via Te Kauwhata on-ramp
- 5 28 November, overnight from 10pm to-2am: Te Kauwhata north-bound on-ramp will be closed with detours via Ohinewai interchange



The final seal with Open-Graded Porous Asphalt will be done in early 2019.
