SH1 Papakura to Drury Project

Stage 1B1 overview

As part of the New Zealand Upgrade Programme (NZUP), an application for Stage 1B1 has been lodged with the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) under the COVID-19 Recovery (Fast-track Consenting) Act 2020.

Stage 1B1 features:

 A pathway along the western side of the motorway for people

- walking and on bikes to improve connectivity, accessibility and safety.
- At Drury Interchange, new bridges across the rail line will allow KiwiRail enough space to electrify the rail line between Papakura and Pukekohe and future-proof for new tracks.
- At Papakura Interchange, a new southbound on-ramp and paths for people walking and on bikes will increase efficiency and improve connectivity and safety for a growing community.

Construction for stage 1B1 is expected to start in 2022 and be complete in 2026.
