

Harewood Road Roundabout Update

Our team is progressing well in the Harewood area. 25% of the excavation for the new shared pedestrian/cycle underpass is complete and 60m of the underpass is installed.

The next step is to enlarge the roundabout island so we can build the underpass in this area. We will make these changes to the roundabout in early January.

In mid-January we will move our large crane to the middle of the roundabout and start work there.

Traffic impacts

- The roundabout will continue to function as it does now, but please be aware of the change in camber and keep to the posted speed limit.
- Occasionally we may have to reduce some of the approaches to one lane during off peak hours.
 Cycle and pedestrian access will be maintained while we are working.
- Parking and speed restrictions will remain in place around our sites, we will also use water filled barriers to guide traffic and protect our crews.

When: Mid January 2016

Traffic: The roundabout will

enlarge in size but will still

function the same way.
