The Supporting Growth Programme is planning the transport networks needed to support future urban growth in Auckland over the next 30 years, including the areas of *Kumeū-Huapai*, *Riverhead*, *Redhills* and *Whenuapai*.

In 2016, Auckland Council, Auckland Transport and the NZ Transport Agency published a high level 'Preferred Network' plan indicating what transport options for public transport, walking, cycling and roading need to be investigated.

Some of the programme's priority projects are already underway, such as the Safe Roads SH16 Brigham Creek to Waimauku project.

The next step is to develop options for the rest of this network and align with Auckland Council's latest land use plans, with the aim of confirming and protecting the full network over the next five years.

Your feedback is vital to help develop options for the future transport connections in your area.
