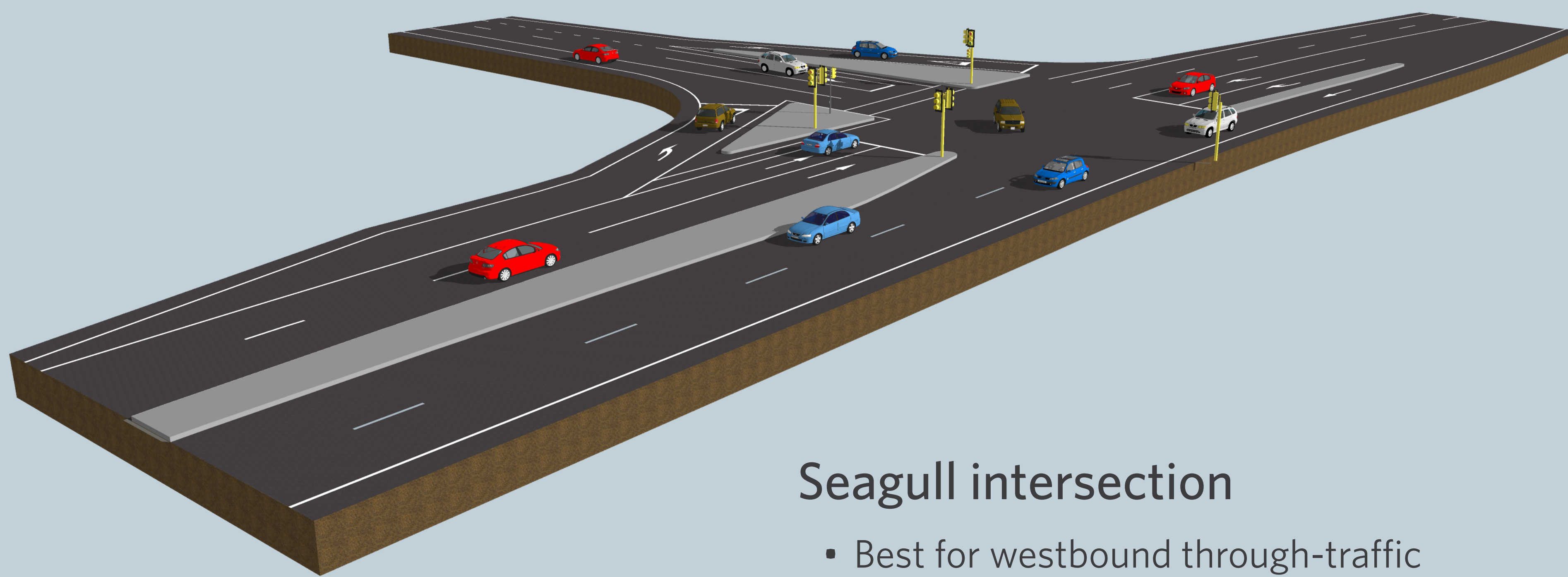


Coatesville - Riverhead Highway intersection

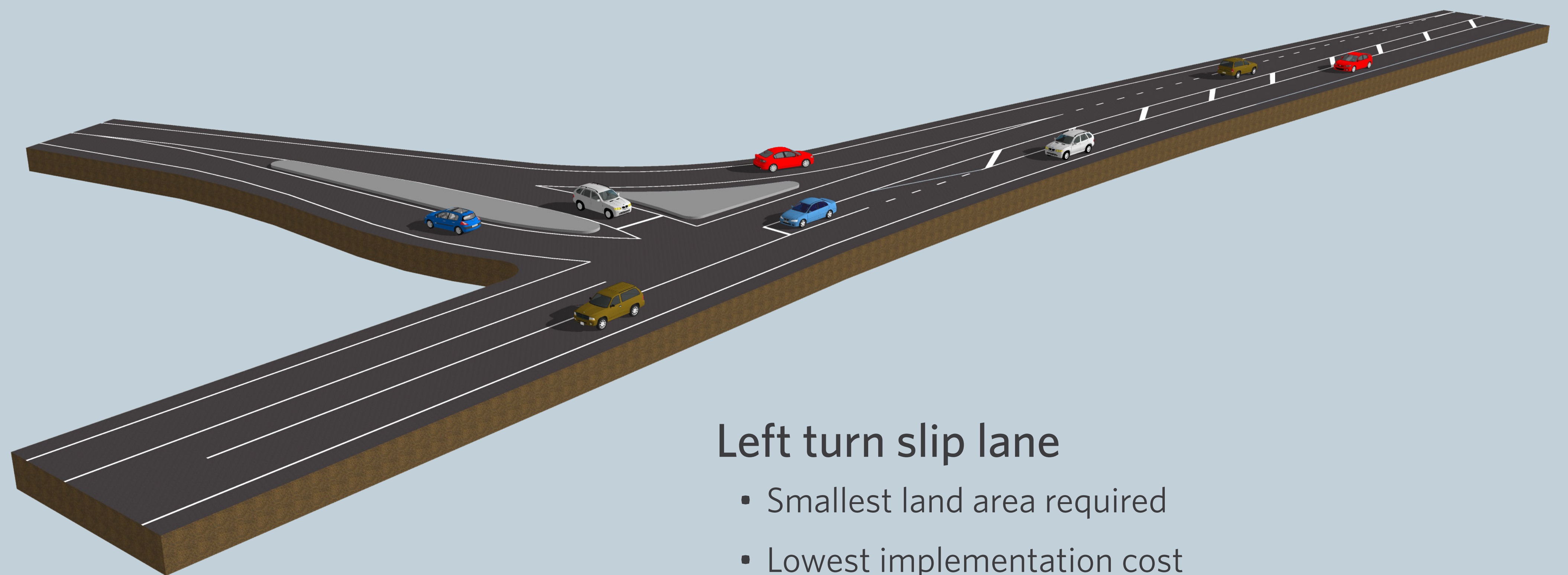


Seagull intersection

- Best for westbound through-traffic
- Could be signalised to provide ease of turning during peak traffic flows
- Not as safe for cyclists
- Inconsistent with adjacent intersection designs at Brigham Creek and Taupaki Road

Considerations

- High predicted serious crash rate
- Poor travel time reliability and long wait times
- History of minor crashes



Left turn slip lane

- Smallest land area required
- Lowest implementation cost
- Only improves the flow of left turning traffic
- No improvement in safety for pedestrians or cyclists
