

# EXTENSION OF THE SH16 NORTHWESTERN CYCLEWAY

As part of the Lincoln to Westgate project, there will be significant improvements to facilities for pedestrian and cyclists.

The Northwestern Cycleway will be extended alongside State Highway 16 to create a 3 metre wide shared walking and cycling path from Lincoln Road to the Westgate footbridge. It will create new transport options for commuters travelling to work and a route that can be enjoyed by the local community at the weekend.

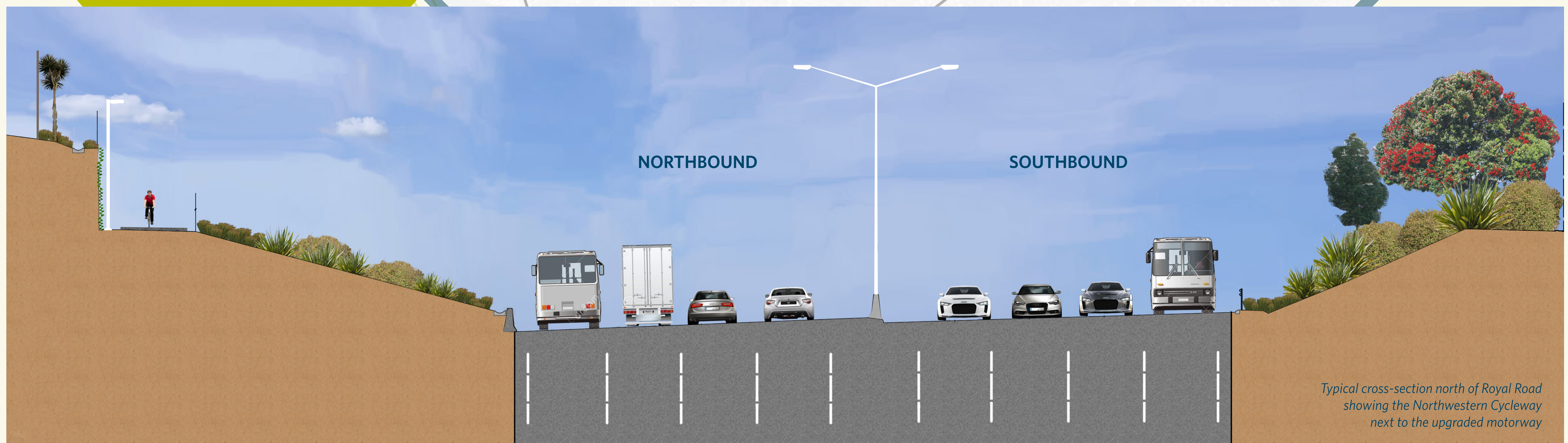
The cycleway will be separated from the motorway carriageway to keep pedestrians and cyclists safe and away from live traffic.

The cycleway route will link up to local roads with connections at Lincoln Road, Huruhuru Road, Triangle Road, Makora Road, Royal Road and Westgate footbridge.



## Royal Road bridge

The new and improved Royal Road bridge will be widened to create 3 lanes for traffic, an on-road cycle lane, a shared walking and cycling path, and new footpath. This will provide a safer and easier route over the bridge for the local community.
