

## CONSTRUCTION OF SH20A TRENCH


The NZ Transport Agency is working to improve safety and journey reliability to, from and around the Airport area. Mangere residents will have noticed significant road layout changes along local roads as the SH2OA to Airport project nears completion. This updates gives an overview of what has been accomplished on the project in the last three months and what motorists can look forward to.

#### LOCAL ROAD IMPROVEMENT



#### KIRKBRIDE ROAD BRIDGE

The opening of two lanes eastbound across Kirkbride Bridge in March was another milestone for the project. Two westbound lanes will be added in mid-2017 along with throw screens that reflect mana whenua themes of arrival and travel.







## SH20A LANDING DRIVE **UPGRADE**

The Landing Drive roundabout will be upgraded to an intersection with traffic lights to improve accessibility, safety and capacity where SH20A ends and the Airport roading network begins.

The upgrade supports the significant traffic growth and development in the Airport Oaks and Verissimo Drive shopping and business areas. It also contributes to Auckland International Airport Limited's 30 year vision of creating the Airport of the future.

The Landing Drive/SH20A intersection upgrade will be completed in early 2018.

# SH20A MONTGOMERIE ROAD INTERSECTION

As part of the upgrade of the SH20/Kirkbride Road intersection, the SH20A/Montgomerie Road intersection will close permanently. More information will be provided when the date of the closure is confirmed.



# WALKING AND CYCLING

The 2km of the shared path that runs along the western side of SH20A from Kirkbride Road to Landing Drive at Auckland Airport is due to open later in 2017.

The upgrade of the Landing Drive roundabout includes extending the cycleway to south of Landing Drive. This section will open early 2018.

Cycle lanes will also be installed on both sides of Kirkbride Road east and west and will link into the shared path.



Planting native trees and shrubs including kauri, totara and native grasses is also an important environmental aspect of the SH20A project. Approximately 82,000 new shrubs and trees will be planted at the end of the project, that's around 1.5 for every person living in the Mangere-Otahuhu Local Board area.



### SH20A TRENCH UPDATE

MHX Kirkbride Alliance celebrated a major milestone in early March when it completed the 'big dig' and the excavation of 100,000 cubic metres of dirt from the trench which runs under Kirkbride Road.

The sump, located in the middle of the trench, is near completion and will sit just under the base slabs. Rain or any other water that finds its way into the trench will flow into the sump before being pumped out into a stormwater wetland.

The base of the trench is made up of 41 slabs. The team has laid 34 slabs and remains on target to open the trench in August 2017.

### STORMWATER WETLANDS

Three wetlands are being built along SH20A to help treat stormwater run-off from the motorway

A stormwater wetland is a large shallow planted pond that filters stormwater runoff, slows down the flow of water and helps to control flooding downstream. It provides an important habitat for a range of native species and helps remove sediments, nutrients and contaminants from stormwater before discharging it into local waterways.

A cultural harvesting area will also be provided where the local community will be able to gather flax for weaving.
