WHAT ARE WE DOING?

As part of our traffic mitigation works in Ashhurst, so far we have completed:

- Mulgrave Street closure
- Wyndham Street upgrade
- The Terrace closure
- Threshold signs (Saddle Road)
- Roundabout improvements

We are working towards completing the following work and will provide updates as the work progresses:

- Town centre safety improvements
- Salisbury Street shared cycleway/footpath and traffic calming
- Bamfield, Lincoln and Worcester Streets traffic calming
- State Highway 3 Napier Road and York Street improvements
- Threshold on Mulgrave Street
- Traffic lights
- Resurface Cambridge Avenue (SH3 to roundabout)
- Hillary Crescent intersection improvements (both ends)

ALTERNATIVE ROUTES

We have also taken over the maintenance of the alternative routes to State Highway 3 through Manawatū Gorge due to the significant increase in traffic on these roads. These roads are Saddle Road, the Pahiatua Track and now Ballance Valley Road.

We are continually working on these roads to make these as safe as possible. We have also undertaken some major works in these areas such smoothing out the Woodlands Road corner.
