Whāngārei to Te Hana is a long-term programme of investment being undertaken by the NZ Transport Agency on behalf of the NZ Government. The programme includes a combination of projects to deliver an upgraded carriageway and safer alignment of State Highway 1 over the next 30 years.

As well as works to create a safer alignment of State Highway 1, a programme of initiatives will be developed to encourage safer driver behaviour, and innovative technology to improve the journey experience.
